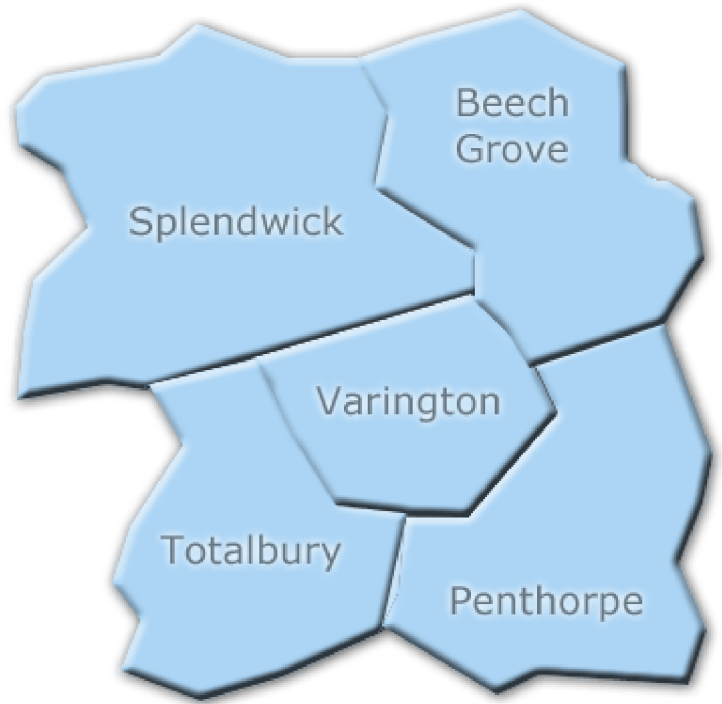


Residents survey - planning in our
